Background:-

This matter has been filed by B. J. Home for Children, saying that the said organization is running children home since 1916. Orphan children in the ages group of 6 to 12 year staying in the home. Total 61 male children and 55 female children are staying in the home. Children residing in the homes, are getting education in the Municipal School, Matunga. However, in the school, one teacher, Shri Kondule tried to sexually assault girl child. This matter is disclosed by girl child on 27th March, 2012. Accordingly, F.I.R. has been registered against the teacher in the Matunga Police Station. Matter has been also reported to the District Women and Child Development Officer. The Commission listed this matter, called the Police Officer. Complainant's Advocate appeared before the Commission. No report has been received from the Police till the date. This matter is old matter and no report has been received either from the Education Department or Police, therefore, on the basis of the complaint, Commission is making following directions:-

- (1) Directing the Police Inspector, Matunga Police Station to submit detailed progress report in this matter.

(2) Education Officer of the Municipal Corporation is directed to take appropriate step against the teacher and also ensure the safety of the children in future.
