



**Introduction:-**

This matter has been filed by the District Woman and Child Development Officer, Wardha, mentioning that on 10<sup>th</sup> November, 2014, one girl child age 16-year filed case in the Police Station, Wardha, under section 376 of IPC and section 6 of POCSO Act, against the accused who committed rape on her. On 11<sup>th</sup> November, 2014, in order to direction given by Member of C.W.C. written statement made by the alleged accused and his father on the judicial stamp, agreeing to marry with the victim and accordingly, victim went with the accused. Marriage between them was solemnized in a temple, as per counseling to provide the maintenance. Shri A. M. Paliwal, Member of C.W.C.

2. The victim was tortured and by the accused she further approached to the Child Welfare Committee. However, dispute of taking any decision and reporting matter, Child Welfare Committee directed her to go to the police station. The complaint reveals that Member of the Child Welfare Committee and District Protection Officer both are involved in this matter.

3. This matter came when District Woman and Child Development Officer alongwith member of the Childline visited the residence of the victim. Therefore, D.W.C.D. has requested to initiate action against the member of the Child Welfare Committee and District Protection Office.

4. The Commission took this matter and listed matter on 19<sup>th</sup> May, 2015 and 25<sup>th</sup> June, 2015. However, on both the dates, neither the complainant nor the respondent were present. Therefore, seeing the gravity of case,


recommendation can be made on the basis of available records. Hence, Commission decided to close this matter for final recommendation.

5. Under above circumstances, the Commission is making following recommendation:-

(i) District Superintendent of Police, Wardha, is directed to conduct investigation by an officer not below the rank of Additional Superintendent of Police and submit the report to the Commission.
