




Background:-

This matter came before the Commission by way of filing appeal under section 35 (3) of Right to Education Act, 2009. In the appeal, appellant has prayed that for admission of his son Jinith Rathod, who is nine years old, he approached to the Respondent's School, requesting them to give admission to his son, however, his request was not accepted by the School. He approached to the local authority, but no response has been received by the local authority. He has mentioned that denying the admission to his son, is attracting the provision of S.C./S.T. Act.

2. The Commission took the cognizance, issued the notices, called the parties. During the hearing, the complainant has prayed for withdrawing his application as his grievance has been redressed. On the request of the complainant, the Commission has allowed to withdraw the application, hence the matter is disposed of without any order.
