Enquiry, under section 13 (1) and 14 (1) of the Child Right Protection Act, 2005.

Case No.202-2013-2014

Background:-

This matter is filed by Shri Ghoneshwar Ramchandra Dhodke, alleging that his daughter and son-in-law has been murdered by some influential persons, name Tukaram Jagtap, Sitaram Shinde, etc. who are closely related with political leader. However, the police have converted the matter of murder into suicidal death. He has mentioned that he has approached to the various authorities in the Government and Human Right Commission also but never get justice. Due to death of his son-in-law and daughter, their children became orphan.

2. The Commission took this matter called report from the police. The detailed report has been submitted by the police. In the report, it is mentioned that following the direction given by the Human Right Commission, this matter was referred to the State, C.I.D. The State, C.I.D. had investigated the matter and found that the case was suicidal death not murder. Therefore, Superintendent of Police, Solapur, has requested to dispose of this matter on the basis of report of Deputy Superintendent of Police, C.I.D.

3. After going through, the police report and order of Human Right Commission, this Commission feels that matter may be disposed of without any recommendation in term of death of daughter and son-in-law of complainant. Since once matter is taken up by any Commission, then this Commission cannot take up matter in view sub-section (2) of section 14 of C.R. C. Act. However, it is recommended that District Women and Child Development Officer should ensure proper care and protection of children of deceased if required under the law.
