
Background:-

This matter has been filed by Smt. Vaishnavi Jayesh Shirke, making allegation against her brother-in-law, Shri Manoj Kajrolkar, who used to come at her residence frequently and touching her son and daughter inappropriately even when he was residing at her residence at that time he had sexually assaulted her daughter and son. Her mother and father-in-law are instigating to her brother-in-law to stay in his house. In this regard, a police complaint has also been filed. However, police is not taking action properly. Alleged accused, i.e. Manoj, filed a written reply and refused the charges and alleged his father and mother-in-law who are old, are being deprived from the basic need by the complainant and her husband. A letter written by complainant's father-in-law against the complainant addressed to the police inspector, has also attached with the reply. So many complaints and counter complaints have been filed in this matter. As this matter is appearing a family dispute matter, therefore, Commission is directed to the Officer from District Child Protection Unit to visit the place and submit the report. Accordingly, the matter is disposed of.
