Introduction:-


This complaint is filed by parents of Learners' Academy making allegation against Learners' Academy saying that School is demanding various types of activities, fees and hiked fees by 112.76% from the year 2010 to 2014. The School is also threatening to the parents that if they fail to deposit the hiked fees, then the report card of the children will be withhold. Thus parents have demanded the Commission to intervene in this matter. Total 23 parents have put their signature and attached copy with the complaint.

2. The Commission took the cognizance, issued the notices to the Education Department and School. The School represented by Advocate, Mr. Premchandra Gupta sought time for one week to file the reply. In the reply, it is submitted that as this matter has been settled with the consent of the parents; therefore, matter is required to be disposed of. School Education Department has submitted that this matter fall under I.C.S.E. Board, therefore, Education Department has no concern. On the basis of written submission

made by Advocate of the School, the matter is disposed of without any recommendation.
