

Enquiry, under section 13 (1) and 14 (1) of the Child Right Protection Act, 2005 and under section 31 (1)(b) of Right to Education Act, 2009.

Case No.27-2014-15

Background:-

This matter is filed by Shri Ghanshyam Sonar making complaint against School Education Department of M. C. G. M. mentioning that under provision of Right to Education Act, 2009 there should be uniformity in the primary education for first to eighth standard, i. e. lower primary for first to fifth and upper primary for sixth to eighth. However, in the schools run by M. C. G. M., still primary education is being imparted up to seventh standard. Therefore, students who are in the municipal schools are facing problem to get admission in ninth standard. Complainant has requested the Commission to issue direction to the M. C. G. M. to follow the provision of Right to Education Act.

2. The Commission listed matter, called parties. Education Officer has admitted that department is trying to bring uniformity in primary education. No reply has been filed by Education Department.

3. In this matter, documents submitted by the complaint shows tht, in the schools run under M. C. G. M. provision of Right to Information in term of

primary schooling for first to eighth standard is not being applied, therefore, this Commission is making following recommendations:-

- (a) To follow up the provision of Right to Education Act, for imparting education for first to eighth standard uniformly to all schools.
- (b) To formulate a time bound program in this regard.
