Introduction:-

This matter has been filed by Lokmangal Sanstha, Charmorshi District, Gadchiroli, requesting to take appropriate steps for protecting the rights of girl child who need care and protection, by allowing the organization to enhance its capacity from twenty children to fifty children. The contents of the letter reveal that in Gadchiroli District, Lokmangal Sanstha is running Children Home for girls, having the capacity of twenty girl children. However, due to civil unrest in the area and situated in remote part, numbers of children who need, care and protection have increased. Therefore, requested the Commission for making the recommendation to the Government to allow the Sansthan to accommodate atleast fifty girl children in the home.

2. The Commission took this matter, issued the notices to the District Woman and Child Development Officer, Gadchiroli and C.W.C., Gadchiroli. However, during hearings, except the applicant, others were not present. Therefore, no reports are available with the commission by which the condition of district could be ascertained in term of number of children who need, care and protection. It is mentioned that this Commission is not authority to issue licenses to run the children home. However, in order to

protect the rights of child. The Commission may make recommendation.

Therefore, the Commission is making following recommendation:-

(i) District Woman and Child Development Officer and C.W.C. is directed to conduct a survey and ascertain the number of children who need care and protection in the district.

(ii) On the basis of survey report, if it is found that number of children homes is less to accommodate the children who need care and protection. Then, submit report to the appropriate authority either to open new children homes or enhancing the capacity of existing homes.
