Background:-

Background:-

This matter came before the Commission by complaint alleging that her son who is minor has been kept by her husband and in-laws and he is untraceable. She has also alleged, act of violence, committed by her in-laws, husband, on her.

2. The Commission took cognizance, issued notices to the concern persons, police officers etc. Respondent No.1 did not appear before the Commission. For non-appearance of Respondent, the Commission directed to issue notice through police department in order to produce complainant's son and respondent before the Commission. However, it is informed by the police that at the given address respondents were not found. Therefore, during next hearing, Commission decided to dispose of this matter on the basis of documents placed before the Commission.

3. Child Welfare Committee, Amravati, has passed an order and directed, Amravati, ha police department to register F.I.R. against respondent and produce child F.I.R. against before the Committee.



4. A report dated 14<sup>th</sup> March, 2015 has been received from the Police Inspector, Nagpuri Gate Amravati. In the report, it is mentioned that case has been filed against respondent and matter is in the Court, however, report did not say regarding custody of child. Another letter sent by same police station mentioning dated 13<sup>th</sup> March, 2015 reveal that despite of best effort by the police, respondent could not be traced.

5. As this matter is in the court, Child Welfare Committee has also passed order. Therefore, only action is required to follow the order passed by Child Welfare Committee.

6. In view of above, the Commission is making following recommendation:-

Police Department is directed to follow the order passed by the Child Welfare Committee and submit compliance report to the Commission. The matter is disposed of accordingly.
