Background:-

Childline, an N.G. O. has filed a complaint saying that one Shri Vinayak Dilip Vetral after beating his wife took away her two year old child on 24th February, 2014 and till filing the complaint i. e. on 27th February, 2014, child and Mr. Vetral both were not traceable. Smt. Lalita, mother of the child, filed a police complaint and approached to the Police Commissioner. However, police did not act on the complaint. Failing to get any response from the police complaint, approached this Commission, requesting to issue direction to the police to search the child.

2. The Commission listed the matter, called the concerned police officer. Police report says that on 25h February, 2014, Shri Vinayak Vetral, who is residing with his wife and two year old daughter found that on the mobile of his wife, a person named Huzepha Sayyad forwarded a message when he asked from his wife regarding relation with Huzepha. Then both have quarreled and he has beaten his wife by using hand. However, after the incident, his sister-in-law intervened and resolved the issue. But at the same time, his wife left the house leaving two year old child. When Lalita did not come, then considering that his wife is missing, he came to the police station for registering missing person complaint. Thereafter police has called his wife and tried to settle the issue. But she refused to go with her husband and through her advocate sent a notice. Police has directed Shri Vinayak Vetral to come alongwith child and child is handed over to Smt. Lalita. Now child is with

the mother. Since child is with the mother, hence, matter is closed without any recommendation.
