Background:-

This matter is filed by one Jitendra Rajaram Lad against his wife Janvi saying that due to strain relation with his wife. He is not been allowed to talk with his daughters who are minor. He has alleged that his wife is not treating well with his daughters. Therefore, girls are in physical and mental trauma.

2. The Commission listed matter, called parties. Respondent, Smt. Janvi has filed reply, refuted charges and placed the fact that divorce petition between them is pending before the Family Court and due to non-co-operative attitude of complainant, matter is not finalized.
3. The Commission directed the Counsellor and Child Protection Officer to visit the house of complainant and talked with the child. Both Officers went and do counseling the children and submitted report. In the report, it is mentioned that both the children are being ready to stay with father and father's family. Both are preferring father than mother.
4. As this matter is in the Court and Court is authority to take decision on the issue of custody of children, therefore, report submitted by the Protection Officer should be placed to the Court.


5. In view of above, the Commission is making following recommendations:-
