Background:-

This matter came before the Commission by Shri Dharmendra K. Mehta, making allegation that his son Master Krishna Mehta was studying in Dr. Pillai Global Academy, Gorai, Borivali (West), Mumbai. Due to suffering from acute cerebellar ataxia, Master Krishna Mehta was hospitalized in December, 2013. After getting the treatment from Nero Surgeon, he is now completely recovered and ready to join the school. However, when the complainant has approached the Principal of the School, the Principal denied to meet him. The Commission took the matter and issued the notice. School Authority has filed written reply. In the reply, it is admitted that when the parents of the child approached the School and requested to get readmission for Academic Year 2014-15, the School Authority has observed the child and found that child is not in a position to admit in the school. In the School, there is no facility to treat the child and once the child is recovered completely then School will admit the child. The School also requested the Commission to call the child before the Commission.

The report from the Doctor has also been placed and after going through the report and opinion of Doctor, it is appearing that child needs treatment.

In view of the above, Commission's recommendations is as follows:-

"Complainant is directed to provide treatment to his child and then approach the school for admission".
