Background:-

The complainant, Shri Pramod Maruti Khandare has approached the Commission, requesting to issue the order with regard to the admission of his three children under the provision of Right to Education Act, 2009. He has further submitted that his matter fall under the provision of 25% quota. However, his children have not been admission under the quota of 25% made for the ward of

students belonging to the weaker section of the Society. He has also alleged that the school has taken donation.


2. The Commission took the cognizance and issued notices to the Education Officer of the School and listed matter on 22nd April, 2014. During the hearing the School and Education Officer both were unrepresented. On next hearing they appeared and stated that notice issued by the Commission is received only on the same date i.e. on the date of hearing; therefore, they were unable to attend the Commission. The content of application is ambiguous and specific relief has not been sought, no document has not been forwarded through which it can be ascertained that the matter of complainant is falling under the provision of R.T.E.

3. After going through the records, Commission feel that it would be appropriate to refer this matter to education officer, directing to settle the issue under the provision of law.
