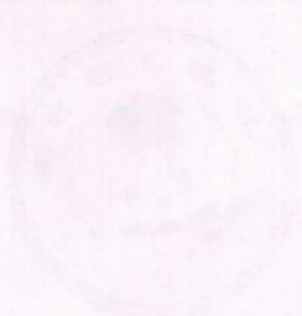



Background:-


This matter is filed by Shri Sanjeev Sharma, complainant, alleging that his daughter Kum. Diya Sharma, who is studying in II B, was locked in the wash room for two hours by senior girl of seventh standard. When he approached to the school staff for making the complaint about incident, the School denied taking the complaint. Principal, Dr. Varsha Punwatkar, has negative and insulting attitude. Thus failing to get any relief from the school, he has approached to this Commission. The Commission took cognizance, issued notices and the matter was heard by the Commission. The School has filed reply through its Council, refuted the charges leveled by the complainant and submitted that complainant's daughter was never locked in the room either by any students or by negligence of this School staff. The School has further submitted that in this matter service of Counselor was taken and report of the counselor established the contents of the reply.

After going through the records and reply of the school, this Commission does not feel to make any recommendation in the matter and matter is disposed of without any recommendation.
