Background:-

One Mr. Kalpeshkumar Palrecha has filed complaint alleging that his twelve year old daughter who is with his estrange wife Kusum Jain alias Teena are being threatened and ill-treated by Kusum alias Teena Jain. He has mentioned that under their customary law, they have agreed to separate themselves and child has been kept under the custody of Kusum alias Teena. He has further mentioned that his daughter's life is being spoiled by his wife and with the help of my wife's father, my daughter has been handed over to Guruma Pushpashreeji for diksha which is curse for the Jain society. Commission listed the matter, issued the notices to the concern and called the report and directed complainant to file affirm complaint alongwith true copies of documents. Affirm complaint has been filed by the complainant, but no report is received from the police, no submission is submitted by opponent.

However, on the basis of contents of the complaint, the Commission is directing to the police to submit the status report in this matter. Accordingly, the matter is disposed of.
