Suo Moto

Background

This matter has been taken by the Commission suo moto on the basis of the news appeared as reported in the newspapers. The Commission took cognizance, issued notices to the concern departments of the Government and asked to file status of the children suffering due to malnutrition, and also directed to submit the detail action taken report in order to eradicate malnutrition in the state in general and particularly in tribal areas. A set of reports filed by the District Women & Child Development officer, Thane, District Health officer, Thane, have been placed before the Commission. Reports reveal that inspite of Government's efforts the problem of malnourished children are still unsolved. The various reasons have been raised in the reports, regarding the problems. The reports reveal that various schemes under the I.C.D.S. and Health department are being going on and somehow the problem is being lessening. The Commission has considered the contents of

the report, statement made by the officers, social workers and measures suggested by the stakeholders, is propounding following recommendations on the issues :-

- i. To carry on fortnightly door to door regular survey to take ~~the~~ ^{stock} ~~stock~~ of new born children, pregnant women and lactating mothers.
- ii. To secure and ensure availability of food items under the scheme of Take Home Ration to child, pregnant women and lactating mothers.
- iii. To carry on various programmes including street plays, folk song etc to have create awareness among masses.
- iv. To organise various programme on cleanliness and sanitation.
- v. To create awareness among families to grow locally available vegetables in and around home stead.
- vi. Organising training programmes in term of cooking, pertaining to retain the natural nutritious items in the food items.
- vii. To create awareness among masses, to consume non polished rice.
