Suo Motu

This matter has been taken up by the Commission suo moto, on the basis of newspaper report appeared in the "Times of India", mentioning that one child name "Tanaz" died after beaten up by her parents. The post mortem report conducted in Sion Hospital showed the girl had burn injuries, cuts, swellings and abrasions all over her body. The parents are denying the same.

2. Commission took cognizance, called the respective Officer of police station and dean of Sion Hospital. During the hearing, the police submitted a report alongwith statements recorded from deceased. In the police report, it is mentioned that the reason for cause of death has been given by Dr. Dehare, Head of Sion Hospital in the Department of Forensic Medicine and Technology. The reasons are being placed are as follows:-

(i) Injuries present over the body of deceased Tanaz Abdul Firdo Sayyad where wearing edges and in healing and / or healed state. Before analyzing the Chemical Officer's report, it is difficult to ascertain whether the death of child is directly related to injuries present over the body of deceased.

(ii) Injuries present over the deceased, are caused by friction and / or impact by blunt object, few injuries are in healing stage, can be caused by heated objects over body parts.

3. The report reveal that forensic reports are still awaited after getting forensic reports, the reason for cause of death may be given. The police report says that once it is established that child has been died due to the burned, injuries, then appropriate action shall be taken against the parents.

4. In the statement made by parent, they have denied for beating the child and admitted that burns and injuries are due to massaging of iron.

5. As this matter is under the police investigation and police is taking required precaution and appropriate steps to investigate this matter, therefore, matter is disposed of directing the police to submit the investigation report before the Commission.
