Background:-

This matter came before the Commission by Shri Santosh Pote, Adocate, making allegations against the St. John Evangelist High School, Marol, Mumbai. The complainant has alleged that on 8<sup>th</sup> February, 2014, Mrs. Tejendra Kaul, School Teacher, during inspection, found that few of the girls in class had not tied their hair properly. On this Mrs. Kaul took a decision and called "Scissor and cut hair of 20 to 30 students immediately. Mrs. Kaul also took help of the barber. The incident happened in the school and students shocked and some of the students did not take their dinner and even felt humiliated. Therefore, this matter is required to be investigated.

2. The School has filed reply and admitted that this is being enquired by school management and proper action would be taken by the School. On the basis of submission made by school, the matter is disposed of without any recommendation.
