Enquiry, under section 13 (1) and 14 (1) of the Child Right Protection Act, 2005

Case No.06/2015

**Background:-**

This matter is filed by Smt. Surekha Dongre, alleging that during the assembly election, services of children were taken by Shri Chandrashekhar Bavankuly, which is violation of right of child. She has further mentioned that using of children for election work attract to provision of Child Labour Prohibition Act, 1986.

2. The Commission, listed matter, called the parties, i. e. complainant and Election Officer. No one was present during hearing. During hearing, it is found that complaint is not filed in proper way. Written reply from Collector, Nagpur, is received on 9<sup>th</sup> June, 2015. The Collector's report says that, during election, engagements of children were not appeared. Therefore, this matter may be disposed of. Complainant neither appeared before the Commission nor produces any evidences by which it can be established that children were engaged during the election. Hence, on the basis of report submitted by the Collector, the matter is disposed of without any recommendation.
