Introduction:-

This matter has been taken up by the Commission suo motu on the basis of news paper report and mail received in the Office of the Commission. In the report, it is mentioned that 6-year old girl was raped by a driver of the School. It is mentioned that driver was seriously assaulted the girl in the month of November also. The driver is working with the Sayadri National School at Warje. Second report which says that one 7 year old girl was raped by one 19 year old youth.

2. The Commission issued the notices to the Education Department, Principal of Sayadri National School and Senior Inspector at Warje Police Station and Vimantal Police Station, Pune. The Education Officer has submitted a report. The Warje Police Station has submitted a report saying that a case has been registered under the various sections of IPC and POCSO against the accused. The accused is arrested and now charge sheet has been filed and case is going on before the Session Judge at Pune. The Education Officer has issued the notice to the Sayadri National School, asking its reply on the various issues including issue to hire the services of private agencies to carry on children and also asked the detailed report that why the action should not be taken against the school including the withdrawal of permission. Going through the report submitted before the commission, a detailed guideline is required to be framed in order to protect the children from the bus driver and conductor. In this regard, this Commission has already issued a detailed

guideline which is required to be followed with letter and spirit to avoid the sexual offence against the child by driver and conductor.


3. In the second matter, the police has submitted report, saying that accused is arrested, matter is in the court, charge sheet is filed.

4. Under above circumstances, the Commission is making following recommendations:-

- (i) Police Officer is directed to file progress report in both the matters.
- (ii) Education Department is directed to submit the progress report regarding, action against the School.
- (iii) To evolve modalities, to stop these types of activities.
- (iv) Follow guideline issued by the Commission.
