**Background**

This matter came before the commission, by the Child Welfare Committee, Mumbai (city). As indicated by the Child Welfare Committee that one Shri Husain Aslam Shaikh who was residing in the orphanage home run by one trust called Anjuman-E-Mufidul Yatama who ran away from the orphanage home, due to negligence of the office bearer of home and for this responsibility lie with trust. Accordingly action may be initiated against trust Anjuman-E-Mufidul Yatama for their omission/ commission. The Child Right Commission took this matter and issued notices to Child Welfare Committee, Mumbai, trustee Anjuman-E-Mufidul Yatama and District, Women and Child Development office with direction to file reply. Superintendent of the trust in her reply has submitted that Mr. Husain Aslam Shaikh, did not run away from the premises of home, but run away during time he was being transported for routine medical check-up at Nair Hospital. He could be able to trace on 15/1/2010 and

readmitted in children home. However further he ran away on 31/1/2010. This also reported to the police. Further he admitted in children home on 10/8/2011 and further he retraced and came back in home. However after twenty days 31/8/2011 he ran away and now still not traceable (time of filing reply). Superintendent of children home in her statement has stated that, she tried at her level best to search the child however unable to retrace. Mr. Jamsing Bijesing Girase, District Women and Child Development Officer have also submitted report. He has retrieved the statement as made by the superintendent of children home. Mr. Girase has mentioned in his statement that since Shree Husain Aslam Shaikh is preferring begging and not interested in studying. Therefore he needs counselling by shifting to other organisation which have counselling facility. After going through the records and statements of District, Women and Child Development officer it shows that, in this matter trustee has taken appropriate step by way of filing F.I.R. and pursuing the matter. Therefore matter need to be closed without any recommendation. Thus matter is disposed off without any recommendation.
