Background

Matter came before the commission from one Mr. Bandappa Nagappa Kamble, resident of Shivshakti nagar, requesting to open Balwadi / Anganwadi in Shivshakti Nagar slums; so that children of slum dwellers could get benefit under the scheme T.H.R., ready to eat material and Anganwadi. The notices were issued to the complainant and Child Development Project Officer, Colaba. Hearings took place on 24/1/2012 and 23/1/2013. Child Development Project Officer appeared before the Commission and submitted written reply. In the reply it is stated that concern area have three Anganwadis. Food items under

T.H.R. and Ready to Eat Material is being provided regularly. Complainant Mr. Kamble also appeared before the Commission and admitted that now Anganwadi is running properly in Shiv Shakti Nagar. Food items under T.H.R. and Ready to Eat Material is being supplied regularly. He has admitted that after Commission's intervention things have been changed, now stratified food is being supplied properly, Anganwadi is also running regularly and children are being given ready to eat material.

As the Complainant has no grievance therefore matter may be disposed off without any recommendation.
