Background:-

This matter is received by the National Commission for Protection of Child Rights, New Delhi, requesting this Commission to take up appropriate action on the complaint filed by one Shri Kishor Tupat, residing at Brahampuri, Dist. Chandrapur, alleging that his daughter Kum. Suhasini Tupat, who was student of Class II in the year 2013, was beaten by teacher of the School, Smt Shalini Chaudhary, with the duster on her back. The same teacher did the same in the year 2011 also. However, the complaint did not get any relief despite of placing the complaint before various officers and political leaders. The complainant has demanded strict action against the teacher including suspension. The Commission took this matter and issued notices to the Education Officer, Brahampuri, Zilla Parishad, Head Master, Complainant and listed the matter on 14th October, 2015 Shri Ahmulwar, Extension Officer,

Brahampuri, was present and submitted a detailed report. Contents of the report say that the Education Department has taken appropriate action against Smt. Shalini Chaudhary, Class Teacher, under sections 4, 24 (1) and 29 (2) of the Right to Education Act. The show cause notice has been issued to the concerned teacher and called her reply within 10 days. After getting the reply, an action shall be initiated against the concerned teacher.

2. As matter is already taken up by the Education Department and appropriate action has been initiated, therefore, Education Officer may be directed to submit the action taken report to this Commission and complainant also and one copy to the National Commission. Appropriate preventive measure should be adopted by the School Education Department not to repeat this type of incident in future. The matter is disposed of accordingly.
