Background:-

This matter has been taken up by the Commission on the basis of news item appeared in Times of India revealing that a 16-year old school girl was gang raped by six persons at different times in the May, 2011. Report reveals that in the month of May, 2011 there may be two accused called her another house to help cook food and when girl enter inside then both locked the door and raped her taking turn and released her with warning not to disclose this to anyone. The other three accused who came to know this incidence and after using the threat of exposing of this incidence called the victim and raped her. Further, another accused on the pretext of exposing the incident raped her. The victim scared so much that when the last time another accused raped her she did not return home and after a long search, her parents and relatives found her and asked the problem. Initially, she was reluctant to tell, but finally revealed how she was gang raped over a month. The parents approached to the police. The police took the initiative and registered the F.I.R. and arrested two accused, others were absconding. Commission took the matter, issued notices called the police and directed police to arrest all the accused and

submit the report. On 13<sup>th</sup> September, 2011, the police has submitted a detailed report mentioning that all the six accused have been arrested, required formalities have been completed. The charge sheet has been filed and matter is with the Court.

2. The police report reveals that the Commission's directions have been followed and accused are arrested. Various provisions of Indian Penal Code have been applied and matter is in the court. Therefore, matter is disposed of without any recommendation.
