

3. The case under section 304 (A) of IPC has been registered against Superintendent, Smt. Ranjana, Head Master, Shri Harishchandra Bhoje and Cook, Shri Bandurao. The investigation is going on. As in this matter one year

has been passed, hence matter is being disposed of, directing police to submit report on the basis of forensic report.
